10. Copies of consent letter(s) for any or all subletting of work performed by contractor(s). (Required under N.Y.S. Finance Law Section 138)
11. Copies of any and all separate bidding specifications for the sub-divisions of the work performed as required by N.Y.S. General Municipal Law Article 5- A.
12. Copies of all advertisements for the contract(s) that were published in newspapers designated for official notices for competitively bid contract(s) as required by General Municipal Law Article S-A.

Please respond to each and every request of the information requested. If, for any reason, any portion of my request is denied, please inform me of the reason for the denial in writing and provide the name and address of the person or body to whom an appeal should be directed.

If there are any fees involved for the records requested, please inform me so I may forward payment immediately.
